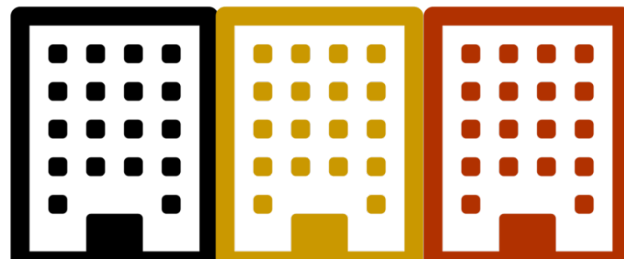

COMMUNITY RISK REDUCTION

- Understanding risks that are unique to our community, developing strategies to address and allocate resources, while monitoring for effectiveness and adapting as needed.
- Data driven decision making to make the biggest impact upon the safety of our community.
- Historically, the FPD has treated risk equally across all commercial and multi-family structures.
- Despite the positive impact of these inspections, our Community Risk Assessment has demonstrated that our community has risk that is unaddressed through current programs.

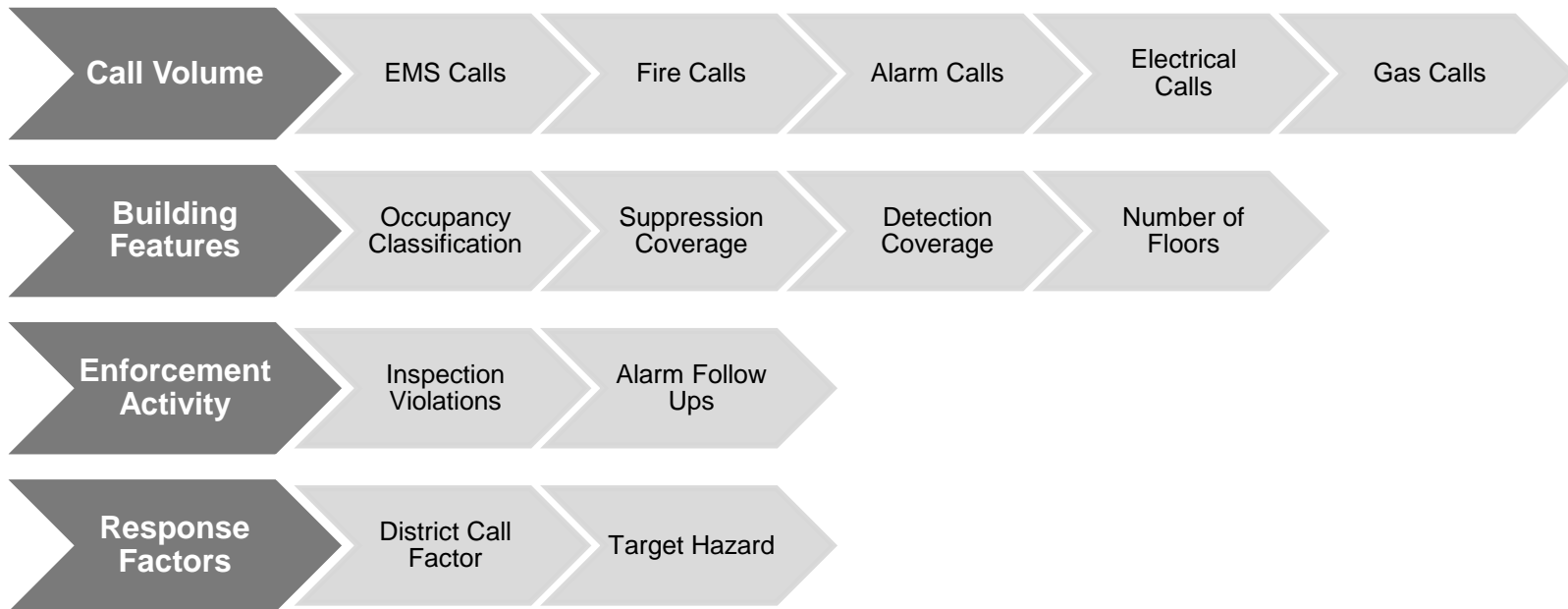

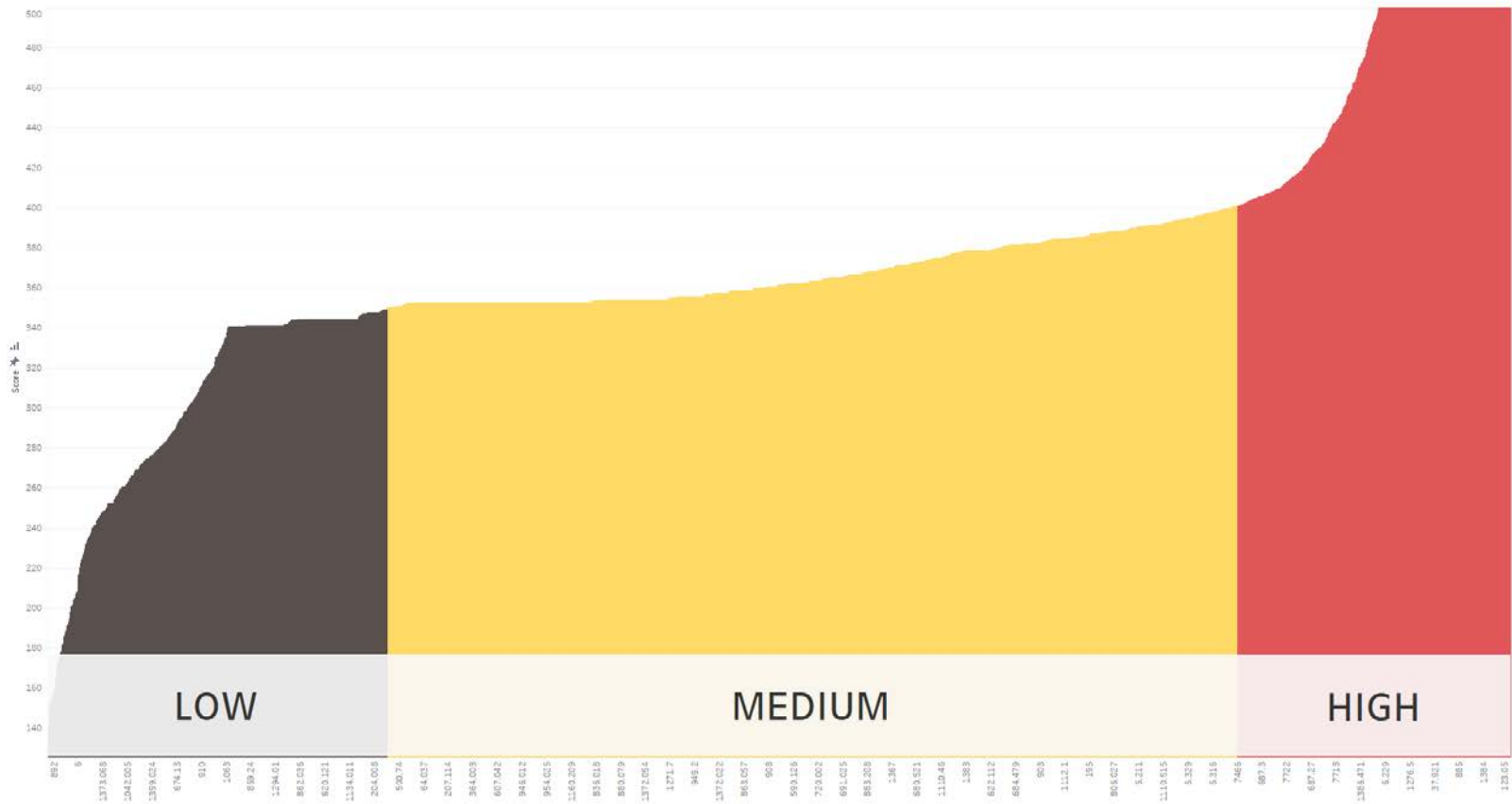
WHAT DOES CRR MEAN TO ME?

- Your “annual” inspection now becomes a “regular” inspection.
- You may be able to participate in helping us to reduce risk across our community.
- You will see additional community involvement from our division.

VILLAGE RISK PROFILE

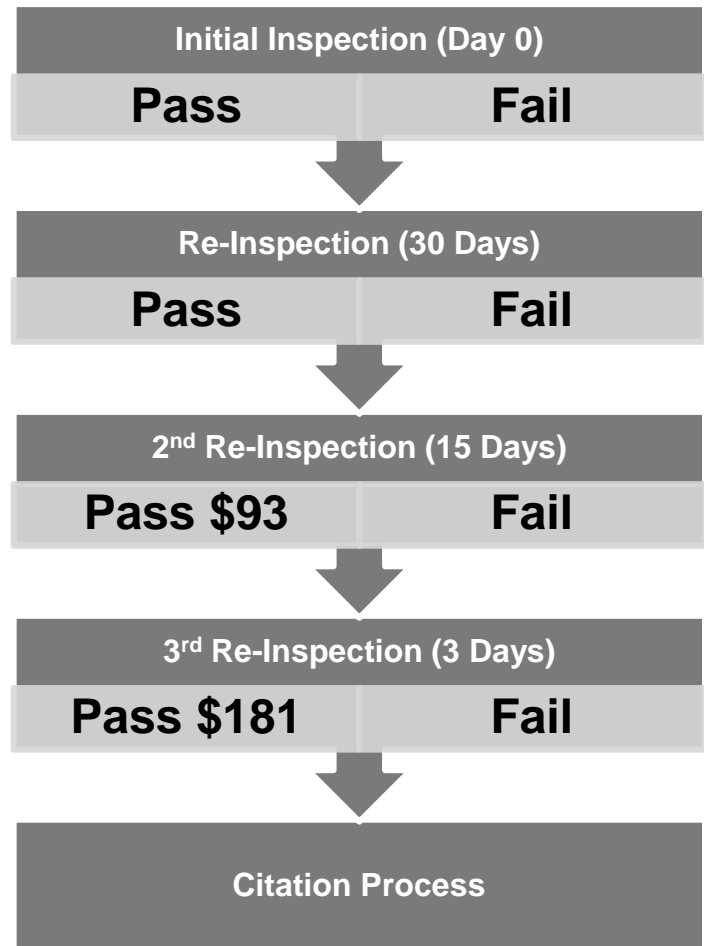


YOUR REGULAR INSPECTION

- Village of Palatine's risk assessment determines the frequency of your regular inspection.
- Any inspections related to a permit are left unchanged, as is the permit process.
- Depending on your occupancy and your inspector, inspections may be scheduled or the inspector will conduct a walk in inspection of your business.

INSPECTION PROCESS

- At the 3rd inspection, the Village assesses a re-inspection fee in accordance with the Village's Fee Schedule.
- If there is non-compliance at the 4th Inspection, the Village will then enter the citation process.
- Violations that require substantial work to be corrected must have an action plan approved by the FPD.



TOP 10 VIOLATIONS

- 1. Emergency Light shall function properly**
- 2. Fire extinguisher Inspection Tag expired**
- 3. Annual Fire Alarm Test is required**
- 4. Exit signs shall be illuminated**
- 5. Exit lights shall function on battery back up**
- 6. Annual Sprinkler Inspection Required**
- 7. Extension cords & daisy chaining are not allowed**
- 8. Doors shall close and latch**
- 9. Proper keys shall be provided for Knox box**
- 10. Ceiling tiles shall be present and intact**
